I solemnly swear that I was born at Buyukdere, Turkey, on or about the July day of 1884, 1889; that my husband emigrated to the United States, sailing on board the Lucania, from Liverpool, on or about the 1893 day of 1893; that he resided 12 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1893 to 1905, at New London Conn.; that he was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Court of Common Pleas, at New London Ct., on the 12 day of September, 1899, as shown by the accompanying Certificate of Naturalization; that I am the wife of the person described in said Certificate; that I have resided in the United States, uninterruptedly, for 1 1/2 years, from 1903 to 1905, at New London; that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at New London, in the State of Connecticut, where I follow the occupation of housewife; that I am about to go abroad temporarily; and that I intend to return to the United States within six months, with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein.
