I, STAVROS FRANCIS PETERSON, a NATURALIZED AND LOYAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport.

I solemnly swear that I was born at BATHEY, COUNTY SAKAY, ERDEK, Turkey on or about the TWENTIETH day of MARCH, 1887,

that I emigrated to the United States, sailing on board of the MAVRE from MAVRE about JULY, 1901;

that I resided EIGHTEEN years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1901 to 1919 at NEW LONDON, CONNECTICUT; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the SUPERIOR Court of CONNECTICUT at NORWICH, CONNECTICUT, on JUNE 4th, 1912,

as shown by the accompanying Certificate of Naturalization; that I am the IDENTICAL PERSON described in said Certificate; that I am domiciled in the United States my permanent residence being at NEW LONDON, in the State of CONNECTICUT, where I follow the occupation of MERCHANT; that I am about to go abroad temporarily, and intend to return to the United States within FOUR [months] [years] with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and that I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose:

Greece TO VISIT PARENTS
Greece TO VISIT FRIENDS

I intend to leave the United States from the port of NEW YORK sailing on board the MEGALI ELLAS on JANUARY 2nd, 1920.
